## ROTATION SCHEDULE FOR THE NON-EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS

This Rotation Schedule for the non-executive directors (the "Rotation Schedule") has been established by the non-executive directors of the board of directors (the "Non-Executive Directors") of argenx N.V. (the "Company") on 9 July 2014 and was last updated on 10 January 2020.

In accordance with the Dutch Corporate Governance Code and to the extent required, in deviation from the Company's articles of association, a Non-Executive Director is appointed for a period of four years and may then be reappointed once for another four-year period. The Non-Executive Director may then subsequently be reappointed for a period of two years, which appointment may be extended by at most two years.

Upon expiration of an appointment term, the Non-Executive Director will resign at the next annual general meeting ("AGM").

The Non-Executive Directors shall retire periodically in accordance with this Rotation Schedule. A Non-Executive Director shall retire early in the event of inadequate performance, structural incompatibility of interests and in other instances in which this is deemed necessary by the board of directors of the Company.
